



Welcome to Cowbridge Cricket Club

In line with Cricket Wales, Cowbridge Cricket Club is following the guidance published for the return to sport <https://cricketwales.org.uk>

We would like to make you aware of the continued social distancing guidelines and the requirement to continue with hygiene behaviour during training, games and whilst at the ground in line with current advice.

In line with current Welsh Government guidance, if you are symptomatic, have tested positive for COVID-19, have been in contact with someone with COVID-19 or are otherwise required to self-isolate, you should not attend the cricket facility and must follow NHS Wales and Public Health Wales guidance on self-isolation. If you are at the club, you are opting to participate in cricket activity and agree to follow the guidelines set by Cricket Wales and the ECB. The sharing of equipment must be avoided and no saliva or sweat should come in contact with the ball. Use of hand gel and bacterial wipes will be provided but please ensure you have access to your own hand gel. If you are spectating once games start, please follow social distancing and do not pick up the ball and throw it back to the players.

Our clubhouse is currently closed other than for essential reasons, such as access to nets and grounds maintenance equipment, or accessing First Aid or medical supplies (these are kept in the scoreboard building) and is newly stocked including access to appropriate PPE. Our fire extinguisher is located inside the corridor to the toilets if needed and is fully serviced. Toilets are closed for training and will only be accessed on a 1 person / 1 family basis when open or if needed for emergency reasons.

We ask that you arrive and leave promptly at training times so as not to increase the number of people at the ground. Should adverse weather come we will communicate this via messaging groups but also please wait in cars until instructed by coaches, captains or officials.

In terms of ground layout at Cowbridge Cricket Club and guidelines for training and games we have laid out a map below for ease.

Please use main car park for parking or alternatively single lane parking behind clubhouse and access the ground via the yellow arrow. There is also additional parking outside of the ground if required. Remember social distancing when arriving and at the ground. There are specific areas for teams to keep their kit when playing or training (please see diagram and key below).

After training, please collect your child from in front of the JB scoreboard / box at the bypass end of the ground. Please use the large spaces available around the ground to view matches when they begin, following guidelines at <https://cricketwales.org.uk>. Training will be either in the nets, on the Astro wicket or on designated areas on the grass. Please bring your own hand gel. We would be grateful for you to bring appropriate cricket equipment for sessions, as we cannot allow children to share equipment.
